The children were excited to showcase their talents at our first Music Recital of the Year. As always it was wonderful to hear all of our musicians!

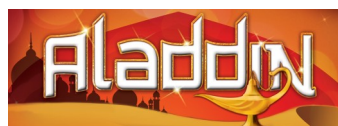


Nativity assembly
