Attendance

Parent Information

- If your child just has half a day off a week (which is one session of absence) your child will have an attendance of 90%. Any child whose attendance is below 90% is classed by the government as a persistently absent child.
- If your child has attendance below 95% your child's attendance will be closely monitored and you may be invited in for an Attendance Panel meeting with the Attendance Officer, a Senior member of School Staff, the School Nurse and the Family Support Worker to ensure your child's attendance improves.

Category	Attendance	What does it mean?
Green	98-100%	Excellent attendance
Amber	97.9%-95%	Attendance has room for improvement
Red	Below 95%	Attendance is a concern and will be closely monitored

Excellent Attendance = Happy, confident child who can achieve their full potential!

Unauthorised absences:

Parents are not allowed to keep their children off school for any of the following reasons: family birthdays, leave/holidays in term time, visiting relatives, looking after other family members, watching sporting events, shopping etc. All these reasons will be UNAUTHORISED and marked with an **O**, **U** or a **G**. Only a few unauthorised absences are required before a **penalty warning notice** can be served. Continued unauthorised absences after this warning has been issued WILL very likely result in an automatic £60 fine. This will rise to £120 if not paid within the first 21 days.

One day is marked as two sessions (am/pm) = 2 unauthorised absences

Authorised Absence

If your child is off ill or has a legitimate reason to miss school, we will authorise the absence as long as the parent/carer notifies the school and can provide medical evidence of absence when requested. Please call school on **0161 226 2066** before 9.30am each day your child is absent.

What absence can be authorised:

If your child is ill, we will give them an I mark. Reoccurring illness will need medical evidence. i.e. Appointment cards/ Hospital letters/a copy of a medical prescription. A Medical absence will be marked with a M as long as an appointment card/letter/prescription are shown but should, where possible be made out of school time.
