Literacy

Our book this week is The Enormous Turnip
Ask your child to tell you about the story.
What happens to the turnip as it grows? Do you know what a turnip is? Who helps to pull up the turnip? What do they do with the turnip at the end?

Your child has been taking part in guided reading – ask them what book they read this week.

Letters and sounds

We are working on phase 4 letters and sounds
Some children are working on CVCC words such as toast and paint– these words have blends at the end such as st and nt and phase 3 phonemes in the middle .
Some children are recapping the phase 2 and 3 sounds for reading and writing.
Can you think of any words at home? Can you write them down?
Practise your reading and spellings every night for a few minutes and talk about the book.

Maths

We are grouping objects in 2's and 10's this week and counting e.g 2,4,6 10, 20, 30 etc. We are making towers of 2's and 10's with numicon to practise our counting.

Can you find some things at home that you could group in 2's and 10's? You could use pencils, toy cars, socks, spoons. Can you practise counting in 2's and 10's

Other

We are making turnips with the playdough
We finding out about pushing and pulling and how to make things move
We are printing with real turnips
We are programming beebots to make them move

Do you have any toys at home that you push or pull?
Can you print with some fruit and vegetables at home?
