- Welcome – tea, coffee and introductions
- Mrs. Humphrey gave updates about school including changes to breakfast club, low attendance at the women’s only fitness classes, children from yr. 2 to yr. 6 are now accessing the field at lunchtimes, yr. 5 reading detectives programme, volunteers needed to paint a fibre glass bee which has arrived for the school and finding information on the website.
- At the last forum meeting some parents suggested that they would like an after school care club. It has been decided that this isn’t something which the school can provide at the moment as there are already lots of opportunities for children to access after school sports and activity clubs.
- Mrs. Humphrey then introduced Kim Wade a behaviour specialist who has been working with the school for the past few months. Kim asked the parents if they were having any problems with behaviour at home. Some parents volunteered issues and Kim suggested ways to support their children’s behaviour, finding positive solutions.
- Kim showed the group a video clip ‘Children see, children do’ and explained that children will copy behaviour that they see from adults both negative and positive.
- It was suggested at the end of the session that a coffee morning ‘surgery’ with Kim would be the best way forward.
