Dear Parents/Carers,

Last week I said we would review routines for the start and end times of the day. As we have all become used to the new system in the morning the vast majority of the children from years 1-6 have been arriving for before 9.00am so from next week Monday 21st September the start times will be as follows:

- Year 6 – Gate A between 8.45 – 9.00 straight into class
- Year 5 – Gate F between 8.45 – 9.00 lining up on the playground before going in to class
- Year 4 – Gate A between 8.45 – 9.00 straight into class
- Year 3– Gate A between 8.45 – 9.00 lining up on the playground before going in to class
- Year 2 - Gate B between 8.45 – 9.00 straight into class
- Year 1 - Gate B between 8.45 – 9.00 straight into class
- Reception – Gate C between 9.00-9.15
- Nursery – Gate C -individual times.

There is a fifteen minute drop off time so please continue to stagger the times you drop your child at school. This will help with social distancing whilst dropping off and collecting your child.

The finish times will stay the same for all classes and we will review this over the coming weeks.

Breakfast club reopened this week. As I explained in the letter from the 7th September we have a new booking system for places. If you want your child to attend please complete the registration form on “Parent app” and then click the link for “SchoolMoney”, which is on the home page of the school website, to book and pay for a place. The entrance time for Breakfast club is 8.00am -8.10 am at gate A. Please contact the office if you need any help with this.

We will be providing hot meals from the week beginning the 21st September. Please contact the school office if you want to make any changes to your child’s mealtime arrangements.

If you have any questions please phone through to the school office and a member of the office staff will be able to help. Class teachers can be contacted by the admin email or by phoning the office and requesting a call back.

The school website was updated over last weekend and we are still working on it. The address has stayed the same: www.claremontprimary.com

If your child or any member of the household has any of the following symptoms, the whole family should isolate and phone 119 to book a COVID-19 test. Please do not come to school. This is really important as we need to protect our children, community and staff.

Symptoms:

- Continuous cough
- High Temperature
- Loss of sense of taste and/or smell

As Manchester continues to be in local lockdown please can we continue to maintain 2 metre distance as far as possible and wear a face covering when dropping of and collecting children.
