

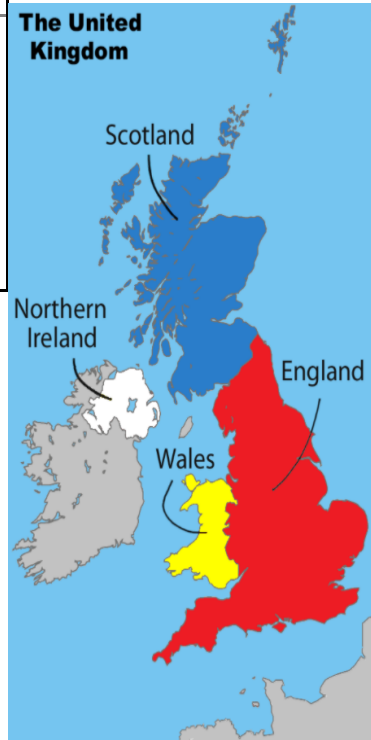

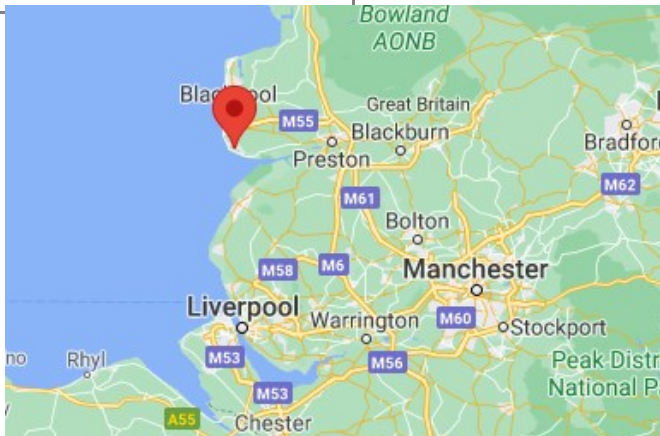
### Vocabulary

<p><b>Human feature</b></p> <p>A feature that has been made or changed by humans.</p>	<p><b>Physical feature</b></p> <p>A feature that has been formed by nature.</p>
<p><b>Compass</b></p> <p>A tool used to show the direction. It uses to North, East, South and West.</p>	<p><b>Promenade</b></p> <p>A public place for walking for pleasure, often by the beach.</p>
<p><b>Pier</b></p> <p>A structure built out into the water for people to walk on.</p>	<p><b>Route</b></p> <p>A way of getting from one place to another.</p>
