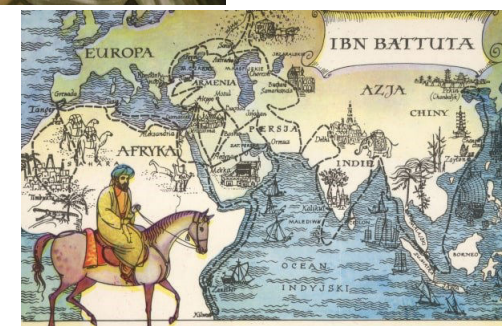
Key Facts

Who: Ibn Battuta
(1304-1369)

Job: Explorer

What did he do?

At age 21 he left home to travel to Mecca to complete his hajj. After that he decided to continue exploring. He visited many countries, including Iraq and Somalia. As well as travel, he studied and wrote a book.



Who: Tim Peake (born in 1971)

Job: Astronaut

What did he do?

He was the first British astronaut to visit the International Space Station. He spent 186 days in space doing experiments to learn more about space. He also did a space walk and repaired part of the International Space Station.
